1. Licht
  - a. Simple (word), group by pos
  - b. Extended (lemma), group by pos [lemma="(?i)licht"]
2. Op school
  - a. Simple
  - b. Advanced [pos="(?i)VZ.\*"][pos="(?i)N.\*"]
  - c. Adapt in extended: [pos="(?i)VZ.\*"][pos="(?i)N.\*ev,.\*"]
3. Het bijvoeglijk naamwoord
  - a. Advanced: [lemma="(?i)het"][pos="(?i)ADJ.\*"][pos="(?i)N.\*"]
  - b. Adapt in extended: [lemma="(?i)het"] [pos="(?i)Adj.\*prenom.\*zonder.\*"] [pos="N.\*ev,.\*"]
4. The adjective *heel* immediately preceding a preposition
  - a. [word="(?i)heel" & pos="(?i)ADJ.\*"][pos="(?i)VZ.\*"]

Other potential examples:

1. *Op verzoek van*: [pos="(?i)VZ.\*"][pos="(?i)N.\*ev,.\*"][pos="(?i)VZ.\*"], group by lemma
2. *Ter plaatse*: preposition followed by a singular noun in Dative case, group by lemma: [pos="(?i)VZ.\*"][pos="N.\*dat\()"]
3. *Man en paard*: Find expressions of the form singular noun followed by coordinate conjunction followed by singular noun (example: *man en paard*). Group by Hit lemma. [pos="(?i)N.\*ev,.\*"] [pos="(?i)VG.\*neven.\*"] [pos="(?i)N.\*ev,.\*"]
4. *Dag in dag uit*: Dutch has postpositions. Find constructions such as *Dag in dag uit* where a singular noun is followed by a postposition, followed by a singular noun and another postposition. [pos="(?i)N.\*ev,.\*"][pos="(?i)VZ.\*fin.\*"][pos="(?i)N.\*ev,.\*"][pos="(?i)VZ.\*fin.\*"]
5. *De medisch specialist*: Dutch has expressions such as *De medisch specialist* in which a singular noun is modified by an adjective without any inflectional ending despite the fact that the noun is a *de-noun* and it occurs in a definite noun phrase (normally adjectives get the suffix -e in such constructions). [lemma="(?i)de"] [pos="(?i)Adj.\*prenom.\*zonder.\*"] [pos="N.\*ev,.\*"]
6. *Op vreemde bodem*: Try to find examples of PPs of the form preposition + adjective + singular noun, such as *op vreemde bodem*. Group the examples by hit lemma. [pos="(?i)VZ.\*"] [pos="Adj.\*"] [pos="N.\*ev.\*"]
7. *Hele grote ogen*. In substandard Dutch, some adverbs modifying an adjective agree with the adjective wrt the property *met-e*. Find examples. [lemma="(?i)heel" & pos="(?i)Adj.\*met-e.\*"] [pos="(?i)Adj.\*met-e.\*"]
